Due to the location of the Azorean archipelago, close to 400 American and European birds can be found here, making it an interesting destination for birdwatchers of all nationalities. More than 33 species of birds nest in the Azores, many of which are endemic subspecies, and two of which are endemic species (the Monteiro's storm petrel and the Azorean bullfinch) meaning they cannot be found anywhere else in the world.

Description

On this specific full day activity you will have the opportunity to explore some of the different bird watching sites of São Miguel Island and discover some of the 33 species of birds that nest in the Azores. One of the highlights of bird watching in São Miguel is the chance to spot one of the rarest birds in Europe: the Azores bullfinch (*Pyrrhula murina*), which can only be found in the Laurissilva forest on the eastern part of São Miguel Island. Many different endemic subspecies can also be spotted throughout the island. If you love birds you should not miss this experience with one of our local nature guides!
